

CODE OF CONDUCT

Continued participation in this program is subject to satisfactory standards of conduct being maintained. Program policy prohibits intoxication or possession of intoxicant, sexual misconduct, use or possession of illegal drugs, stealing, smoking, disorderly conduct, violence, malicious destruction of property, or refusal to cooperate with program leaders. Participants found to have willfully damaged program equipment will be asked to reimburse the cost of replacement or repairs. Failure to uphold the rules of this program will be grounds for dismissal. If such should occur, the participants involved will be sent home at his/her parent's/ own expense. Dismissal is very rare, and we hope this will prove to be totally unnecessary.

In addition, GCignite 2019 includes the following code of conduct:

- Christian standards will be maintained and encouraged including:
- Respect for the opposite sex and no sexual misconduct
- Respect for each other – no abuse/bullying, practical jokes or foul language
- Respect for staff members – co-operation with dorm and activity leaders
- Except during an organised discussion group, female dormitories are out of bounds to all males and vice versa
- No camper may leave the camp without the consent and knowledge of the camp director
- Lights must be left off in the dormitories after the specified “lights out” – be considerate!
- Everyone is expected to participate.
- Attendance at all sessions is compulsory unless otherwise stated
