

Things you can do, or watch others do:

- Under the stars movies, or just enjoy the stars

DIRECTIONS TO THE SELZER'S FARM

Travelling from the North

Take the Hume Highway to Wangaratta, take the Great Alpine Road to Myrtleford. Proceed through the township of Myrtleford towards Bright for 5 km until you reach 'Ovens' (it's a 1 pub town!), continue past the pub for less than 1 km and turn right into Selzers Lane.

Travelling from the South

Take the Hume Highway to Glenrowan (you'll know you're there when you reach a BP service station and McDonalds on the highway in the middle of nowhere!) Proceed past the service station and take the Milawa exit. Cross over the highway and head for Milawa on Snow Road. Continue until Snow Road intersects the Great Alpine Road and head for Myrtleford. Proceed through the township of Myrtleford towards Bright for 5kms until you reach 'Ovens' (it's a 1 pub town!), continue past the pub for less than 1 km and turn right into Selzers Lane.
